

Parent Information about the Senior Scrapbook

It has been the custom for the Senior Parents/Families to make a scrapbook for their child to be shared at the Senior Brunch at the end of the football season. In this scrapbook, parents place pictures/ articles illustrating/relating to their player's high school career in sports. Parents, it is your discretion as to the contents of the scrapbook, the scrapbook can illustrate participation in football only or it can include any and all other sports related to your child. It can cover their senior year only, high school or sports beginning in grade school. A simple photo album is fine or you can design a scrapbook. This is simply something for your child to have to remember their athletic career at Beaver Creek High School. The players really enjoy looking through each of them during the Senior Brunch.

Pictures of your child or of the team can be obtained from many sources including team pictures, newspapers, team poster and personal photographs. Some websites, such as www.creeksportsonline.com make game pictures available for purchase. Information will be posted when 2005 photographs are ready. On www.beavercreekfootball.com each varsity game summary can be accessed from the main page or the varsity schedule page and will include a few sources for varsity-game write-ups. Any parent wishing to write game summaries for the website should contact the football club at bcfbclub@yahoo.com. Freshmen game summaries are written by a parent this year and can be accessed from the *Freshmen team page*. It is recommended parents collect this memorabilia early in a player's high school career.

For your information, there are many scrapbook stores in the area. Many have pre-cut materials specific to Beaver Creek Football and other sports. They also have work evenings when you can go and work on scrapbooks in their store.
