

Beavercreek City Schools has instituted the pay to participate fee. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities who desire to do so and follows the defined rules, regulations and code of conduct.

This fee does not guarantee playing time in athletic contests. That decision will be made by the coach, based on ability, skill and attitude.

Fees for grades 9-12 are \$100.00 per athlete per season per sport, maximum of \$200.00 per athlete per year. (Exception Ice Hockey)

Fees for grades 7-8 are \$70.00 per athlete per season per sport, maximum of \$140.00 per athlete per year.

There is also a maximum of \$250.00 per family. There are no fees for managers, statisticians or student trainers.

High school fees will be collected by the athletic office and middle school fees will be collected by the main office of each respective school by the date set by the Director of Athletic Services. If fees are not paid or arrangements have not been made by the appointed time the athlete may not continue in the sport until fees are paid.

Refunds will be pro-rated if a student athlete is injured and unable to complete the season. The athlete must have doctor certified reason for not participating. No other refunds will be given.

Make checks payable to “Beavercreek City Schools” and indicate athlete’s name and sport in the memo section. We also need to have your home phone number on the check.
